## Mobile Crisis Response

Victim Services provides mobile crisis response services for fatal accidents/suicides at the request of law enforcement or victim's request.

---

**The alleged suspect in this incident has been arrested for a qualifying offense of domestic violence.**

According to Utah State Statute (U.C.A. 78B-7-80), the arrested party may not be released unless they see a judge, or they agree to sign a Jail Release Agreement and abide by it's terms.

The Jail Release Agreement makes the arrested party agree to the following:

1. They will have no contact with the alleged victim.
2. They will not threaten or harass the alleged victim.
3. They will not knowingly enter onto the premises of the alleged victim's residence, or any premises temporarily occupied by the alleged victim.

A judge may modify the Jail Release Agreement upon reading the probable cause statement of the arresting officer, and may opt to not require stipulations one and three.

If the arrested party violates this agreement, they will be charged with a third-degree felony, if they were originally arrested for a felony, or they will be charged with a class A misdemeanor if they were originally arrested for a lower misdemeanor.

**If the alleged victim (who is not a minor) in this case chooses, they may waive any condition of a jail release agreement by:**

1. Appearing in person at the jail or correctional facility that releases the arrested person from custody; **or**
2. Appearing in person at the clerk of the court of the jurisdiction where the charges are filed.
